

Harp Ensemble Performance Attire

Performance Attire:

Formal attire, all black

- Dress, skirt, or dress slacks (no leggings or athletic pants)
- Dress shirt (no T-shirts)
- Black dress shoes (black socks if socks are worn)
- Dresses & skirts: $\frac{3}{4}$ length or longer
- Sleeve length: any (see below for details)
- No excessively low necklines or bare midriffs

Options:

Black skirt or slacks and black dress shirt:

Purchased as needed. Women's dress shirts can have any length of sleeve. (Make sure the sleeves allow adequate arm movement.) Men's dress shirts should be long sleeved, black, and worn without a tie.

Ensemble dress:

These dresses are owned by longtime members of the ensemble but are no longer available to purchase.

Black dress, purchased:

Talk to me if you are interested in purchase options. Ordering may take several weeks, so plan early.

Black dress, borrowed from Gretchen:

I have a closet full of black dresses, including a couple that are very similar to the ensemble dresses. I'm happy to loan them out as needed for ensemble performances. Talk to me several weeks before a performance if you are interested in a loaner dress. I can bring several options to a rehearsal for you to try on.

School orchestra attire:

School orchestra dresses usually work well. Make sure that the sleeves allow adequate arm movement. School orchestra tux pants are fine but should be paired with a plain black men's dress shirt.
